ABOUT THE NEW TEMPLE OF LIGHT

- A symbol of peace, hope and unity open to all.
- A cutting-edge architectural masterpiece designed by Patkau Architects of Vancouver.
- Grand Opening & Strawberry Social June 23, 2018, with ribbon cutting, tours, socializing.
- Constructed during 2016-2017 to replace the original Temple that burned in 2014. The first Temple arose from a vision of Swami Radha and was completed in 1992.
- Local contractors and suppliers helped build this Temple, including Spearhead, an innovative fabrication company synchronistically located across Kootenay Lake near Nelson.
- Tours of the Ashram and Temple are offered regularly at the Ashram. First community events were held in fall 2017 – a Celebration of Life, an Interfaith Climate Action Vigil and regular satsangs.
