The Temple of Light Rises

On November 7 and 8, 2016 the primary structure of <u>Yasodhara Ashram's Temple of Light</u> in Kootenay Bay, BC was assembled.

This stage of construction sees a dramatic visual transformation in the process of rebuilding. The original Temple was destroyed by fire in June 2014.

"Even though this is one small temple in the Kootenays, we see it is a symbol for hope and peace in the world, open to people from all spiritual traditions," says Ashram President Swami Lalitananda.

The reconstruction of this building with its cutting-edge design and powerful message of inclusivity serves as a testament to the resilience of Yasodhara Ashram's international and local community.

Construction partners include Nelson's <u>Spearhead Inc.</u>, a multi-faceted manufacturing company that specializes in building steel and timber structures. Spearhead is one of few companies in the world that works with the specific technology required for this unique project.

Award-winning Vancouver based firm <u>Patkau Architects</u> is the team behind the design of the Temple of Light. "We've been practicing architects for over thirty years," says John Patkau of himself and his partner Patricia Patkau, "and this will certainly be the most remarkable thing that we've constructed."

With the supporting structure in place, the petal design of the building will be put together incrementally over the coming months. Construction is expected to be completed by summer 2017.

"Seeing the vision begin to manifest is a joy. It's a process of innovation and collaboration among our community, the architects, fabricators and builders all coming together in harmony," says Swami Lalitananda. Yasodhara Ashram is a yoga retreat and study centre founded by Swami Sivananda Radha in 1963, in Kootenay Bay, British Columbia, Canada.
